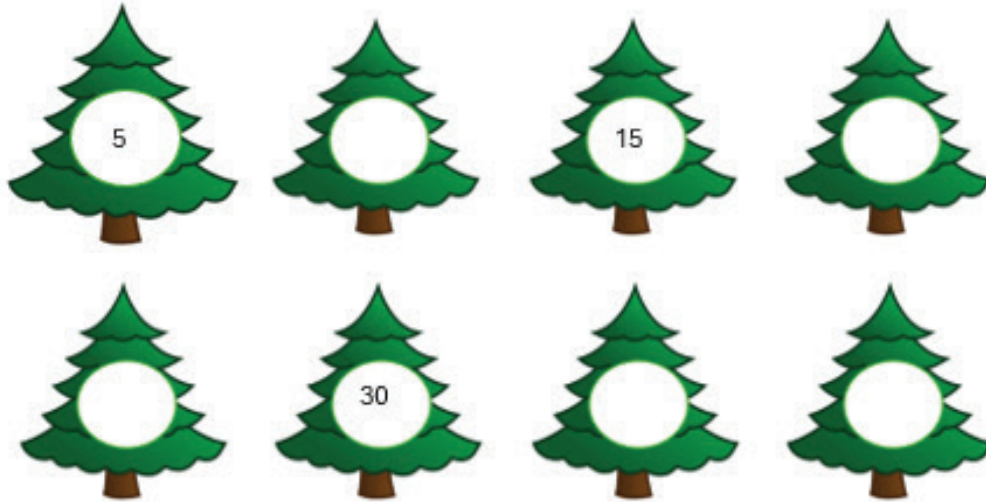
## Words to Know

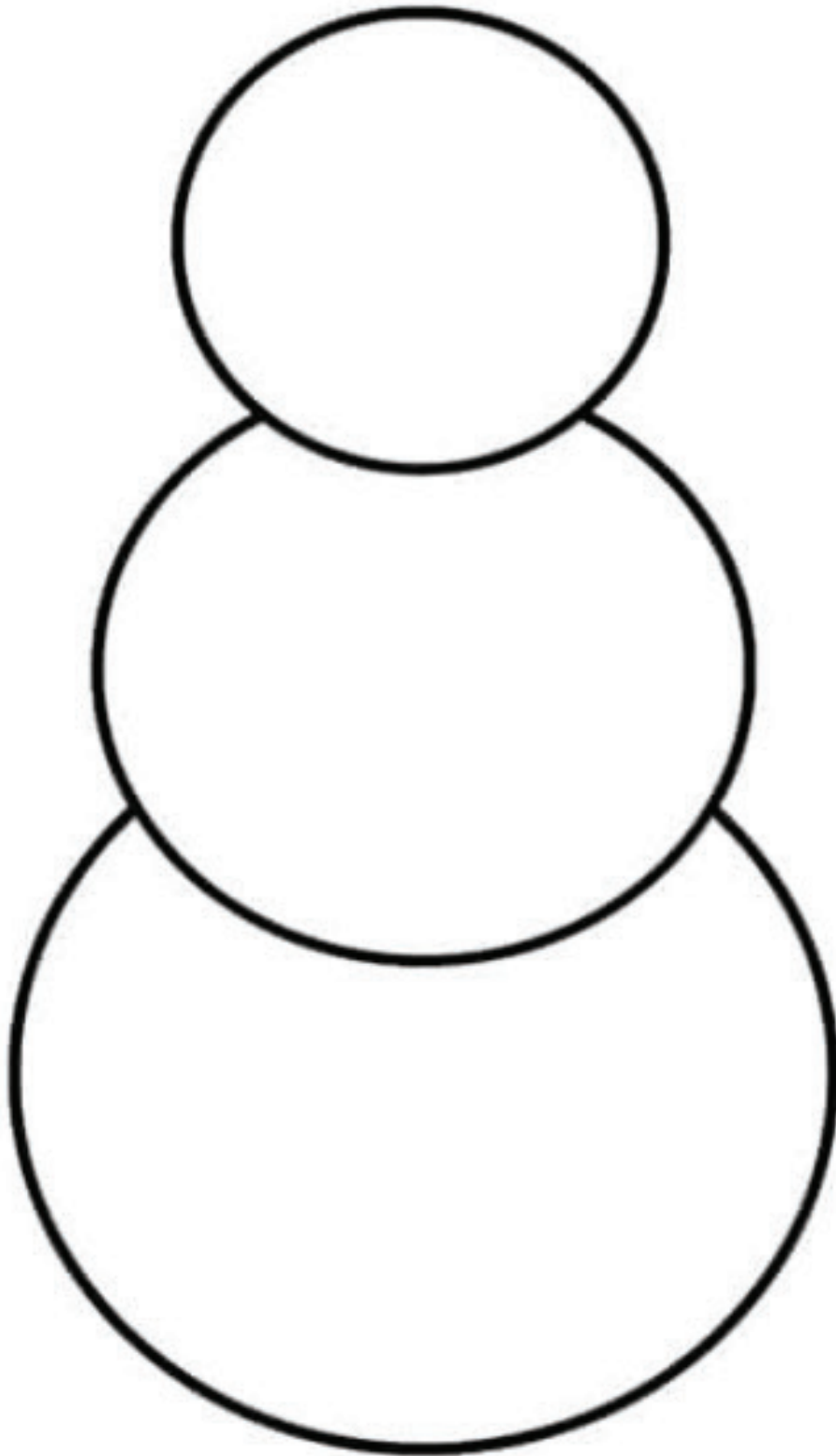

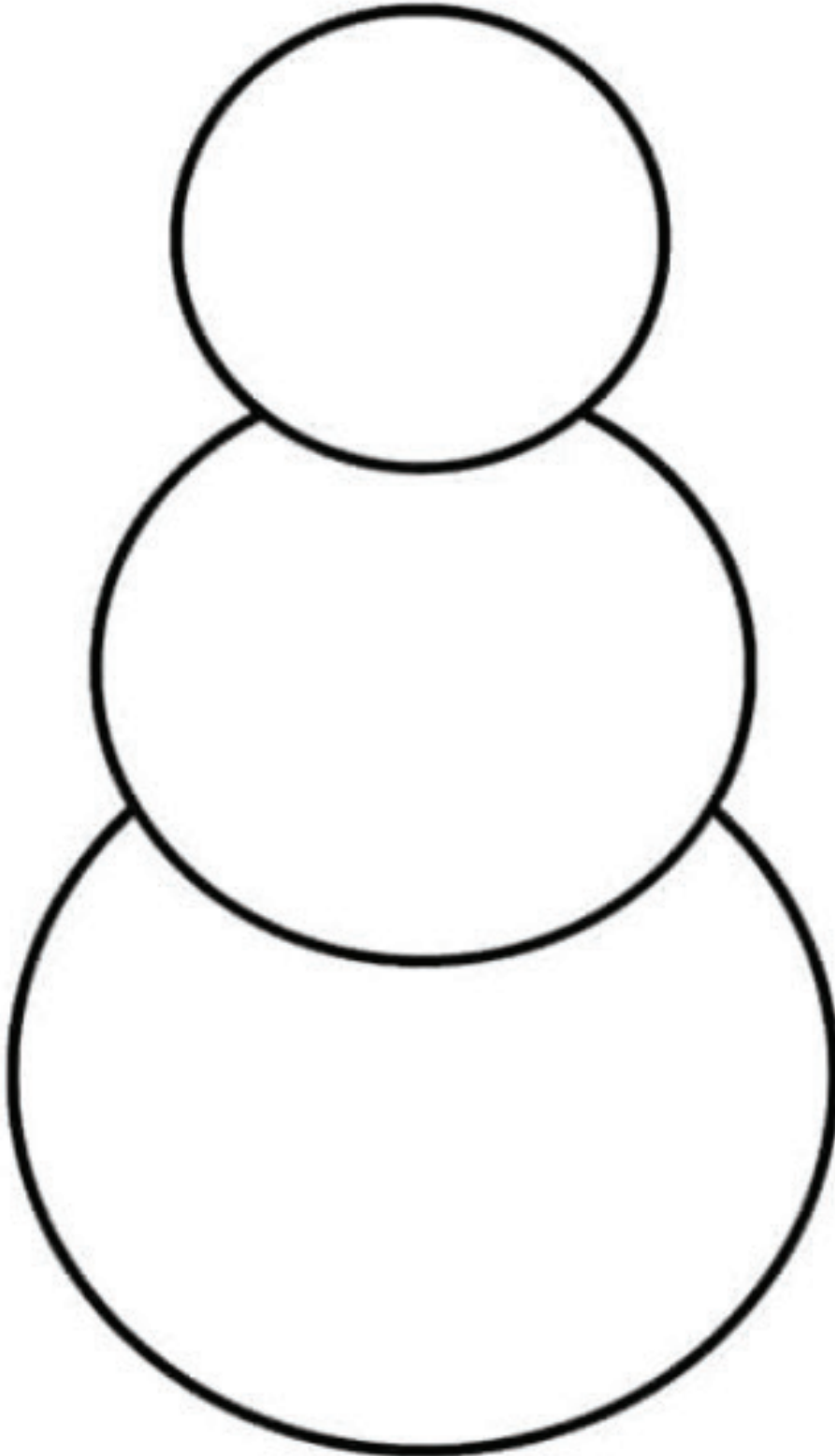
